Nikon D3400 24.2 MP CMOS Digital SLR with Auto Focus-S DX.

Nikon D3400 Firmware Update – D3400 is a straightforward version of D3300. This is the entry-level DSLR that is targeted for the first ILC shooters and those who are ready to move on from their smartphone to more advanced shooting platform.

This camera is built with sensor CMOS APS-C 24MP which equals found on its predecessors along with image processor 'EXPEED', 4 Full HD video capture and auto-focus system 11 points. Unfortunately, the camera does not have Wi-Fi, but it has Bluetooth connectivity LE to transfer images from the camera to smartphones via the application 'SnapBridge.'

Nikon D3400 Features.

D3400 not add much. It's not uncommon for Nikon lately, often adding very few new features when they update their entry-level cameras. Example case: compared to the older D3300, only an increase in weighting/D3400 Nikon is a lower size, battery life is better, and SnapBridge (how to transfer photos to your phone through Bluetooth). Given the difference of more than 2.5 years between the two cameras, it's not much better.

What does all this mean that the camera is Nikon D3400 bad? Far from it. In terms of picture quality, this is one of the least expensive cameras on the market to feature sensors that impressive. If you take pictures of travel, landscape, architectural drawings, portraits, etc., D3400 will function similar to upper-class Nikon DSLR in many ways. But there are many reasons why this is considered "entry level" DSLR Nikon, as you'll see later.

Check the camera firmware version.

1. Turn on the camera.
2. Press the camera MENU button and choose the Firmware version in this settings menu to display the camera firmware version.

Is it possible to use the Remote Photography feature of Snapbridge to control my Nikon 3400D with an iPhone?

Is there any way to use the "Remote Photography" feature of Nikon's Snapbridge app to control my D3400 with my iPhone?

I tried, but it only allows me to download pics from the D3400.

2 Answers 2.

SnapBridge version 2.5 (and up), allows for Remote Control over Bluetooth (in addition to remote control over WiFi). E.g., D3500 doesn't have WiFi either but Remote Control is possible with SnapBridge (https://nikonimglib.com/snbr/onlinehelp/en/05_remote_02.html). HOWEVER, for reasons only known to Nikon, it doesn't make the same available for D3400 (I guess it's b/c D3400 is an older product, they don't want to invest the resource needed to update the firmware for this function).

No, it is not possible. The D3400 does not have wifi, which is required for Snapbridge-enabled cameras to be controlled by the remote smart device.

The D3400 makes it spectacularly easy to shoot and share DSLR-quality images. Nikon's SnapBridge¹ keeps the camera connected to your smart device via Bluetooth® so you can actually sync photos as you shoot. . ¹ As the D3400 does not support Wi-Fi, the following SnapBridge features are not available: remote photography with a smart device , still image transfer in original size, movie transfer.

Aside: Interesting (rather, annoying) that I couldn't find the same clear information on Nikon USA's site.
